The Shasta County Arts Council seeks exhibition proposals for participation in the Old City Hall Gallery. Works representing both traditional and innovative approaches to the Visual Arts will be considered. All media will be considered.

The Shasta County Arts Council reserves the right to determine suitability regarding:

1. method of presentation
2. content regarding that which may be determined "inappropriate" for public viewing.

ELIGIBILITY:

Majority of works to be exhibited must have been completed and not presented regionally in an exhibition within two years of Old City Hall scheduling. Artists may not hold a major show in Redding simultaneously.

APPLICATION REVIEW:

Applications submitted with a self-addressed-stamped-envelope (SASE) of appropriate size will be returned by mail. Applications submitted without a return envelope cannot be returned. The Arts Council is not responsible for loss of or damage to slides or CD's.

ENTRY PROCEDURES:

Initial selection for a show is by submission of slides/CD's. Artists must send the following to the Arts Council:

1. A non-refundable screening fee of:

2. A current resume - typed
3. A brief artist's statement and description of work to be exhibited
4. Samples of 10 works of art (20 per group entry) indicative of your style. Slides and Digital Images on a CD are acceptable. List images from one to ten (20 per group). Images submitted for review need not represent the proposed exhibition theme, but must be indicative of the artist's style and medium to be represented. (i.e.: Artist may not exhibit clothing if proposal was for an exhibition of paintings.)
5. Images on CD's must be no larger than 400 pixels in height.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

Proposals will be considered on the professional level of:

1. Quality and content of artwork
2. Quality of application presentation
3. Contribution of artwork to a balanced yearly program with a wide variety of media.

Due to limited gallery scheduling, SCAC reserves the right to combine applicant artists in exhibitions. Individual exhibitions are rarely scheduled.

EXHIBITION SPECIFICATIONS:

Artwork accepted for exhibition must be READY FOR PRESENTATION (i.e., framed with appropriate hardware for hanging. Items requiring specific display instructions must be designated as such in proposal for consideration by the Gallery Director.) No piece may be withdrawn before the close of a showing. Sold art is picked up by purchaser at the end of exhibit.

FEEES:

An exhibition fee (PER ARTIST) of ____\$35____(SCAC member)/____\$70____(non-member) will be charged to help defray costs per exhibition.

REPRODUCTION:

For publicity purposes, the Arts Council reserves the right to photograph art works accepted for exhibit.

INSURANCE:

SCAC does not carry fine art insurance. Artwork is hung at artists' risk. SCAC takes all necessary precautions to assure safety of works on display in the Old City Hall Gallery.

The Shasta County Arts Council was established as a non-profit corporation in 1981 to promote artistic and cultural awareness and participation throughout the county. The Arts Council also manages and operates the Old City Hall Arts Center, which includes the Old City Hall Gallery, the upstairs Performance Center, a video facility, and classroom space downstairs.
