Exhibit Dates: February 20 through March 22, 2008

Awards Reception: Friday February 22, 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Purpose of Exhibit: To select a body of work which best represents the finest examples of school work in Shasta County High Schools.

Eligibility: Open to all Shasta County high school students grades 9-12

Certificates of Awards: Best of Show, Award of Excellence, and Certificates of Merit.

Jurors: Nancy Lynn Toolan and Troy Hawkins. Ms. Toolan is a mixed media artist who exhibits both nationally and internationally. She currently teaches at Shasta College. Mr. Hawkins is a self-taught artist focusing on jewelry, hand-painted silks and found object assemblages/collages. He is the founder of Chalk-It-Up, Sacramento.

Categories: Original works only—no reproductions. Original works of art created *directly* in the computer are acceptable. No clip art. Two dimensional work must be appropriately matted. **No frames.** Maximum size is limited to 3 feet by 3 feet, including mat, and weighing no more than thirty lbs. **No more than two works per student.**

Delivery For Judging: Teachers, please collect and deliver work on Saturday, February 9, between 11am and 3pm, or Tuesday through Friday, February 12 through 15, between 9am

and 5pm. Deliver to Shasta County Arts Council, Old City Hall 1313 Market Street, Redding.

Judging: Work will be juried on Saturday, February 16, 2008.

Notification: A works accepted list will be faxed to schools by Tuesday, February 19, 2008.

Pickup of Non Accepted Works: All works not accepted must be picked up Tuesday through Friday, February 20—22, 9am—5pm or Saturday, February 23, 11am—3pm.

Pick Up Of Works in Show: All works must be picked up Saturday, March 22, 11am—3pm, or Tuesday through Friday, March 25—28, 9am—5pm.

Liability: All reasonable care will be given to all works submitted. However, all works will be handled and displayed at the artist’s risk. The Shasta County Arts Council will not be responsible for loss or damage to any works in its custody.

Sales: Sales are encouraged. Work not for sale must be marked NFS on the entry form. A 10% commission will be taken on all sales.
