Eligibility: Open to all Shasta County high school students grades 9-12

Certificates of Awards: Best of Show, Award of Excellence, and Certificates of Merit.

Categories: Original works only - no reproductions. Original works of art created *directly* in the computer are acceptable. No clip art. Two dimensional work must be appropriately matted. **No frames**. Maximum size is limited to 3 feet by 3

feet, including mat, and weighing no more than thirty lbs. **No more than two works per student.**

Delivery For Judging: Teachers, please collect and deliver work between 11am and 5pm Tuesday and Wednesday, February 28-29 to Shasta County Arts Council, Old City Hall 1313 Market Street, Redding.

Judging:

Work will be juried March 2 and 4.

Notification: All works accepted list will be faxed to schools March 7-9.

Pickup of Non Accepted Works: All works not accepted must be picked up 11am-5pm Tuesday-Friday, March 13-16.

Pick Up Of Works in Show: All works must be picked up 11am- 5pm Tuesday-Friday, April 17 - 20.

Liability: All reasonable care will be given to all works submitted. However, all works will be handled and displayed at the artist's risk. The Shasta County Arts Council will not be responsible for loss or damage to any works in its custody.

Sales: Sales are encouraged. Work not for sale must be marked NFS on the entry form. A 10% commission will be taken on all sales.
